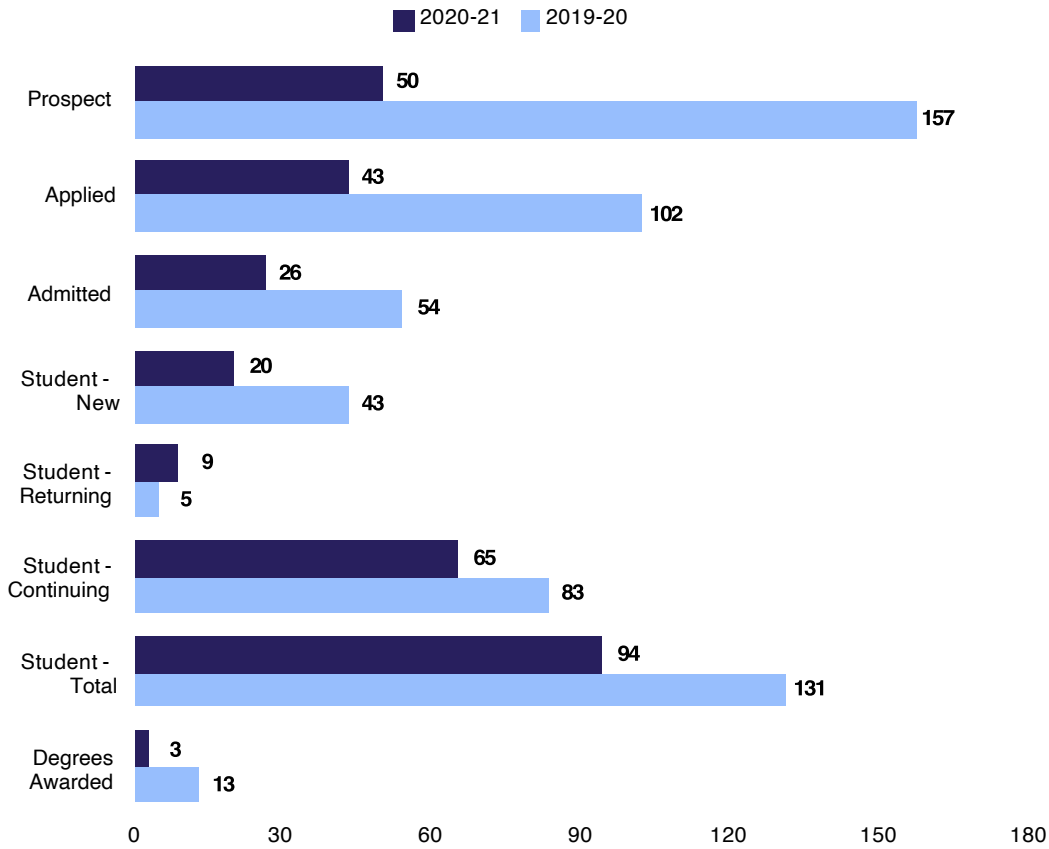


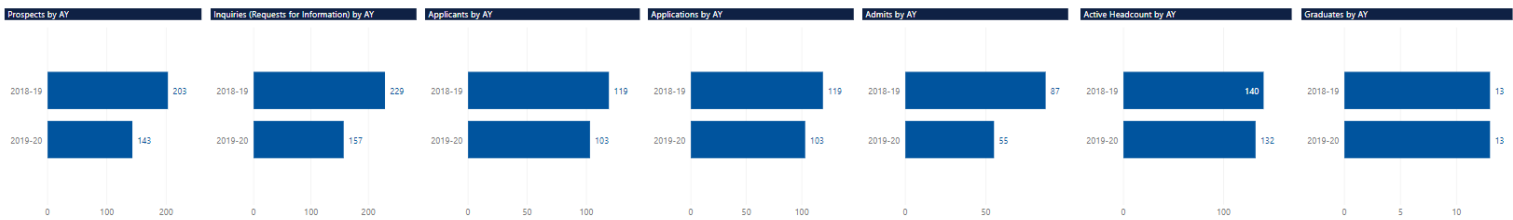

3) Graduated = certificate/degree must have been earned within the specified length of time since entry and could have been different from original intention, or conferred by any ERAU campus (WWW, DB, PC)

4) Counts are unduplicated. students who earned multiple credentials are counted once, based on the credential earned as of that point in time

5) Counts are cumulative and represent a running total of students who earned that credential up to that point in time
