Cost: Offers a net price/estimated cost that is realistic for me and meets my budget.

Financial Aid: Offers sufficient financial aid opportunities (institutional scholarships, grants, work-study programs, etc.) that can help me lower costs.

Campus Life: Has the campus culture and "personality" that I'm looking for.

Extracurriculars: Offers clubs, organizations, activities, etc. that interest me.

Learning Format: Programs are offered in my preferred learning modality (residential, fully online, hybrid, etc.)

Facilities: Offers living, learning and recreational facilities that meet my standards.

Support: Offers student support services (tutoring, career guidance, mental health/counseling, etc.)
